

Wildlife and Photography School - “*Creative Nature Photography*” Masterclass

Terms and Conditions

Price

The total cost for a “*Creative Nature Photography*” Masterclass with Laurie Campbell from 20-24th May or 21-25 October, for 3 entrants is £2,200. This cost will be the same even if fewer entrants attend.

Payment

We ask for a deposit of £100/person (£300 total) from each club to be paid 1 week after 12th March 2020 with the balance due 6 weeks before arrival at Kirkwood. We require the names of the 3 entrants from each club, with email addresses and 1 mobile telephone contact at the time of entry.

We accept payment by cheque (made payable to Kirkwood Cottages or Real Farm Holidays), debit cards (at no extra cost) and credit cards (with a surcharge of 3%). Once booked and paid for no refunds are given under any circumstances and we recommend that you purchase a suitable holiday insurance policy to cover you for any unseen eventualities.

All entrants must agree that they are happy to receive communication about Wildlife and Photography Schools after the event unless they instruct otherwise e.g. in the event of one of the winning teams dropping out we will need to contact the next club.

Accommodation

We will contact you shortly before arrival with detailed arrival instructions and kit list.

Based at Kirkwood, your accommodation will be in one of our [holiday cottages](#) situated in the Stables Courtyard. You will have your own bedroom but will share a cottage with a fellow “student” and communal rooms such as dining rooms are used by everyone. Some bedrooms share bathrooms with one other “student” but en-suite bathrooms are available for a small supplement. Accommodation, meals (lots of [Real Farm Meat](#)). Snacks. all tuition and stated activities are included in the price. Alcohol is not included.

Weather and photography

Entrants are reminded that weather can be highly changeable and varied when working with outside photography and wild species. Entrants may opt out of any part if they wish to rest, and the itinerary may have to change depending on the weather conditions. Only force majeure would prevent the whole event from taking place because we can learn indoors.
